Mineola Ties Rabbits 7-7

A green, inexperienced team went to Mineola Sept. 10, 1948, for the first game of the season. The Yellowjackets, with an exceptionally deceptive "T formation" kept the Rabbits on the defensive most of the game. Teel, Atlanta's fullback, scored in the opening period and Hefner made the conversion. Mineola tied the count in the fourth quarter.

Game Captains: Hefner and Davis

Atlanta 24, Gilmer 14

Sparked with 3 TD's by Teel on runs of 60, 55, & 50, Yds, the Rabbits came from behind in the fourth quarter to defeat the Buckeyes. Hefner scored the other TD on a long pass from Hudspeth. Bad breaks kept the Rabbits in the hole most of the game.

Game Captains: Nichols and Hudspeth

Rabbits 27, Tigers 7

Mt. Pleasant came to Atlanta full of hopes but excellent line play by the Rabbits made that hope only a dream. Musgroves scored one touch-down and passed for two more, to lead the Rabbits over the slightly favored Tigers.

Game Captains: Davis and Clements

Atlanta 27, Winnesboro 7

Spending a lot of time in the air, the Rabbits marched to a decisive win over Winnesboro. The second string, which also outclassed the Red Riders, played a great portion of the game.

Game Captains: Hefner and Heath

Rabbits Rout Roughnecks 12-7

A blocked kick in the first quarter set up White Oak's only tally, but the Rabbits fired back twice in the second quarter to win the ball game. The second half was a hard fought battle with neither team scoring.

Game Captains: Davis, Nichols, and Hayden

Atlanta Dumps Clarksville 46-7

The Rabbit line, composed of Nichols, Hefner, Davis, Willis, Clements, Heath, and Hayden, held the Tigers to only 14 yds, from scrimmage, Atlanta piled up its largest score of the year against the team that was supposed to win the District title. Hudspeth scored on Atlanta's first play from scrimmage in the first and second quarters.

Game Captains: Davis and Musgroves

Atlanta 32, New Boston 0

With the first string failing to click the second team took over, to score on a pass to Milam with only a few seconds gone in the first quarter. Scoring were: Milam, Hefner, Nichols, Teel, and Hudspeth.

Game Captains: Clements and Hefner

Atlanta 7, DeKalb 25

Over confidence, 145 yds. of penalties, and a sudden change of the weather helped a greatly inspired DeKalb eleven defeat the Rabbits. Penalties brought completed passes back three times in succession all inside the five yard line the closing minutes of the half. Coming back playing good ball in the third quarter the Rabbits scored their only tally when Hudspeth went over from the one.

Game Captains: Davis and Nichols

Rabbits 40, Bulldogs 0

Bouncing back from their first conference loss in four years, the Rabbits played good ball all the way. Teel scored on Atlanta's first play from scrimmage. Wet weather held the passing attack down or the score might have totaled even greater.

Game Captains: Hefner and Hudspeth

Rabbits Trounced Linden 45-2

In the last game of the season the Rabbits fired up again, to score on the second play from scrimmage, and Gandy intercepted a pass and scampered for a TD with only a few minutes gone in the first quarter. A blocked punt in the fourth quarter gave Linden its only two points of the game.

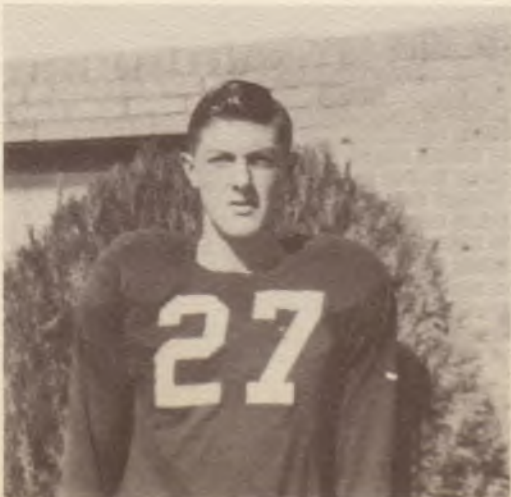

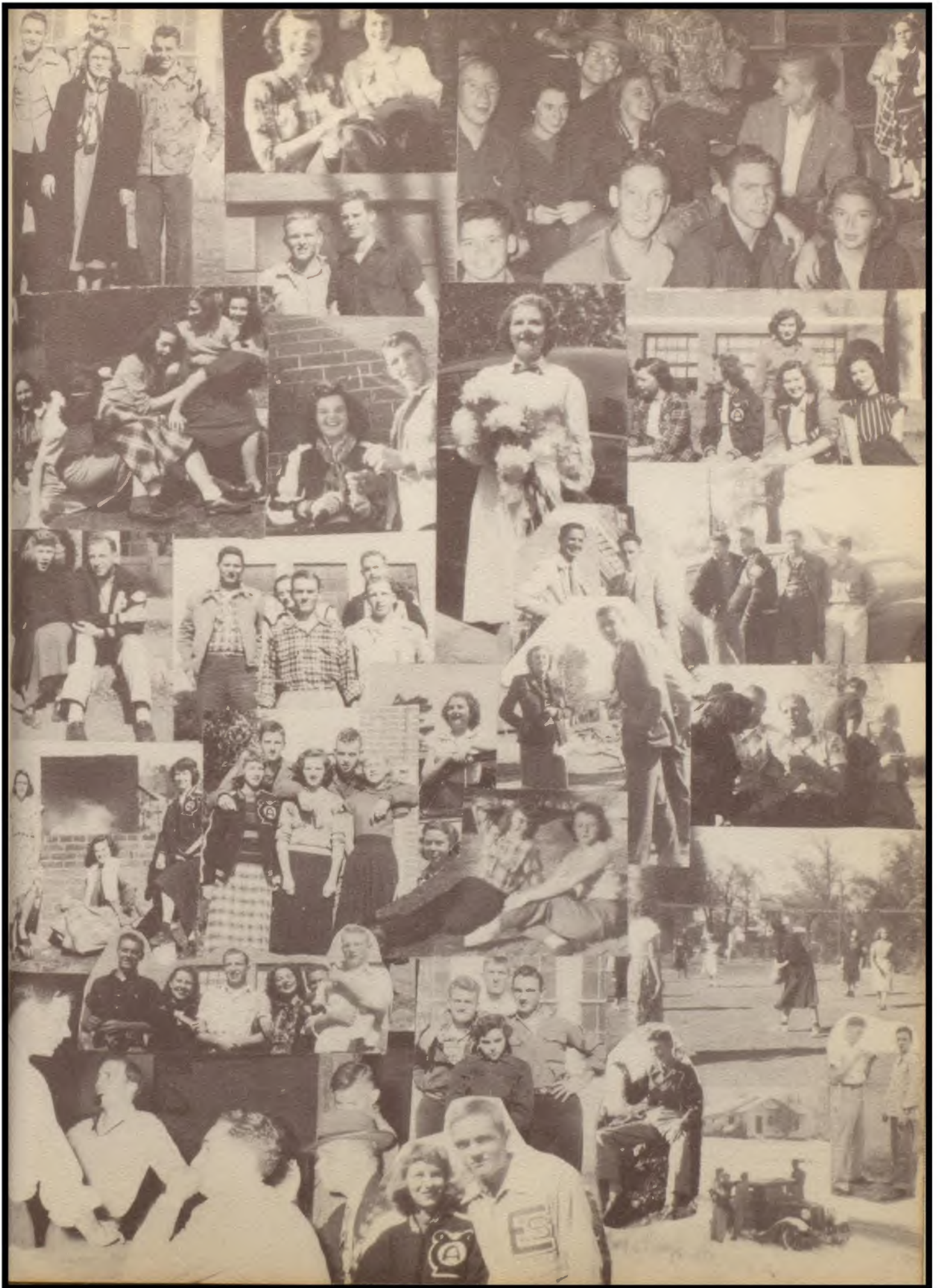




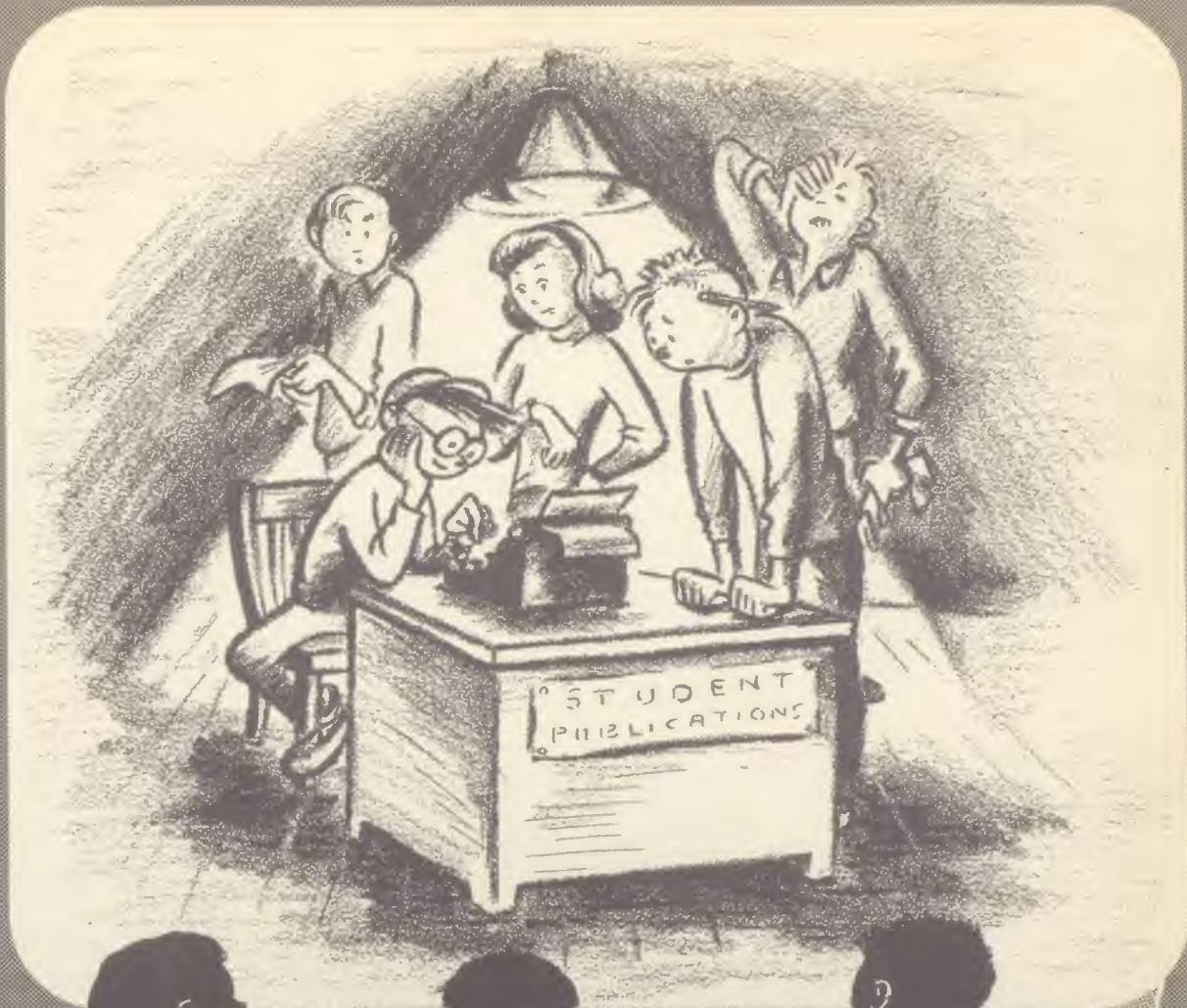

At the close of a week's time the first elimination was held. The four girls left in the queen's race were: Frances Brown, Senior; Geraldine Jones, Junior; Shirley Brabham, Sophomore; and Patsy Mays, Freshman.

The final votes were counted November 11, by Superintendent B. H. Hudspeth. Frances Brown won the race with a grand total of \$801.40 and was named Football Queen of the Atlanta Rabbits for 1948 and 1949.

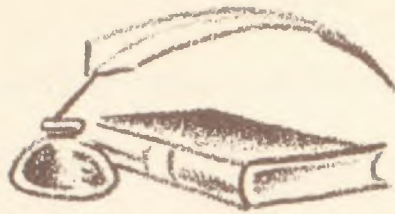
