# Class of 1974 holds 30-year reunion

"We May Never Pass This Way Again" was the class song for the Atlanta High School class of 1974, but they did - 30 years later at the class reunion June 12 at Mattie Lanier Richey Community Center.

About 85 attended the evening festivities, including 49 classmates, said reunion organizer Steven Smith. The class of '74 has about 175 graduates.

The reunion committee also included Keith Crow, Linda Bickham Smith, Jeri Mason Steger, Karen Heath Tromza, Margaret Miller Fitts, Leigh Walker Stanley, Judy Waldon Lanier and Belinda Law Pettit.

The reunion day began with an informal picnic at the sports complex. The alumni gathered that evening for dinner and music by classmate Cathey Cannon Foreman of Brien, who has

a classic rock band with her husband, Bryan.

During the program, Smith and Crow presented a dialogue of events for the class years together. About 40 classmates started first grade together in Atlanta.

Smith and Crow recalled the time one classmember lost her skirt in elementary school when it got hung on the playground swing after she jumped out, bus trips to football games, pep rallies, being the first class to complete four years in the then-new high school, band competitions, the boys basketball team going to state in their senior year and a few pranks, including the time some girls in home economics spiced up a casserole with dish detergent and sent it to the office to be sampled.

Awards were given for a variety of "accomplishments," such as best preserved to

Linda Bickham Smith and Chuck Partain; most gray hair to Pam Green Coats and Keith Crow; most children to Dennis Starling; longest marriage to Cheryl Rounsavall King; and most changed to Belinda Law Pettit and Jerry D. Wall, among other awards.

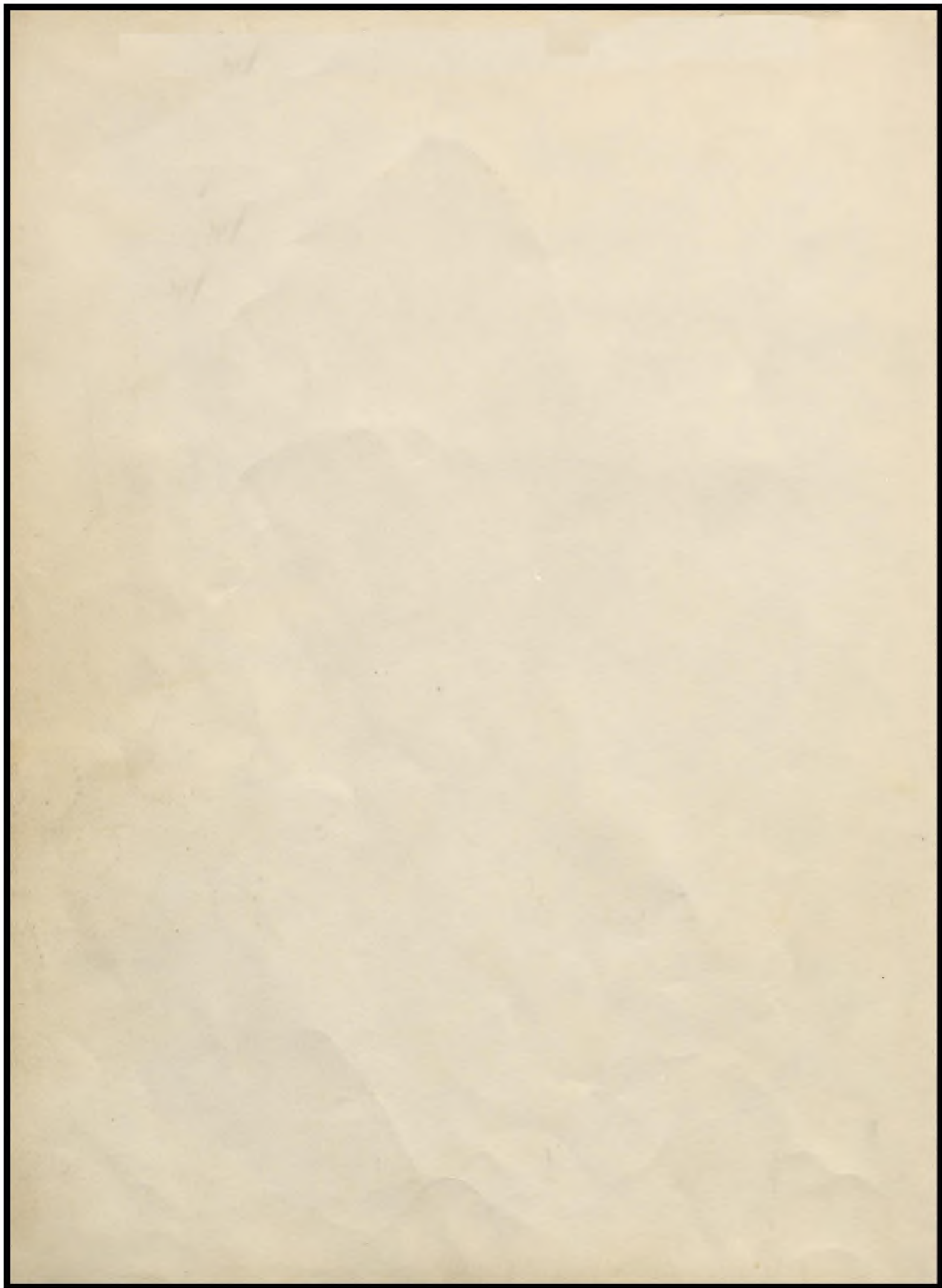
In the past 30 years, class

You can pardon Atlanta basketball coach George Frost some days if you spot him walking around saying "I told you so."

All year long, the Rabbit coach has confided to close friends and associates that his 174 cagers possessed the ability and potential to reach the state basketball tournament.

Naturally, Coach Frost held back on his comments publicly,

because he didn't want any hint of overconfidence creeping into his squad.

And, he didn't want opposing coaches in District 7-AAA to live his words as ammunition to lure up their own teams against the Rabbits.

All the regular season and playoff games are behind the

Hares now, and you can think off opponent-when-opponent which has been sought in the dust of the Rabbits' 25-4 season.

As a result of that record, Atlanta is in the state meet starting Friday, with Gonzales, 14-AAA representative, as the opponent in an 8:30 p.m. game. The other contenders are

## Postal Rate Hike Midnight Saturday

Area residents will pay more for postage, effective midnight Saturday, March 2, according to Postmaster Sam Ed Henderson.

All first-class mail weighing 12 ounces or less except postal and post cards, will increase from eight to 10 cents per ounce," Henderson explained.

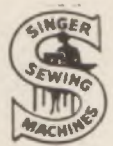

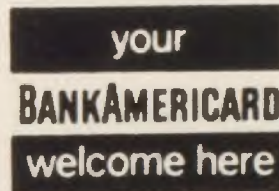
