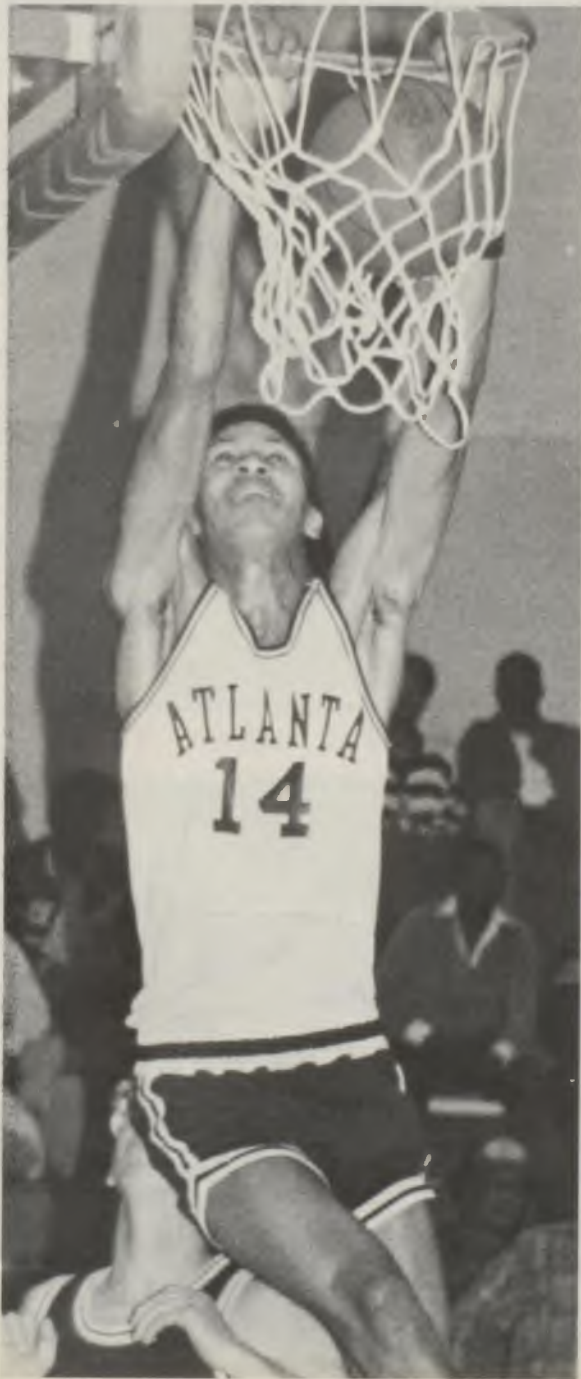
## Stats show Rabbs succeeded
