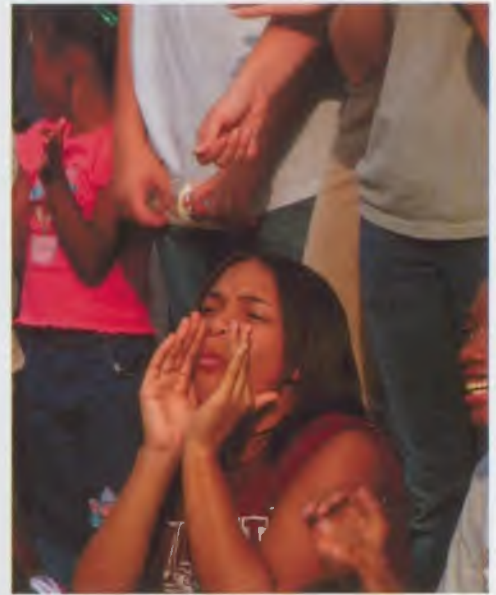

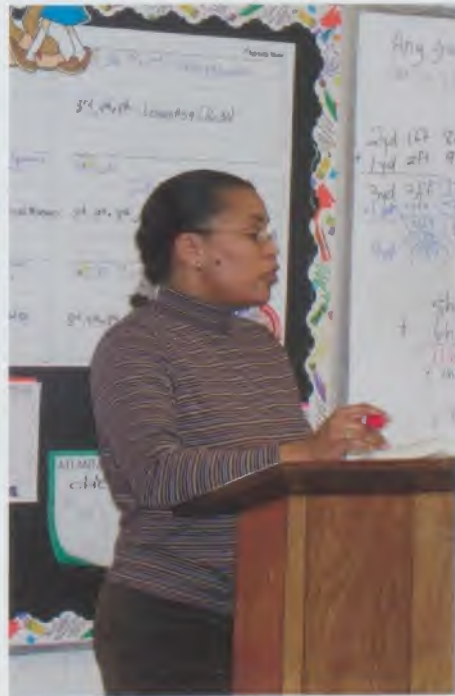






### Rabbit Love
