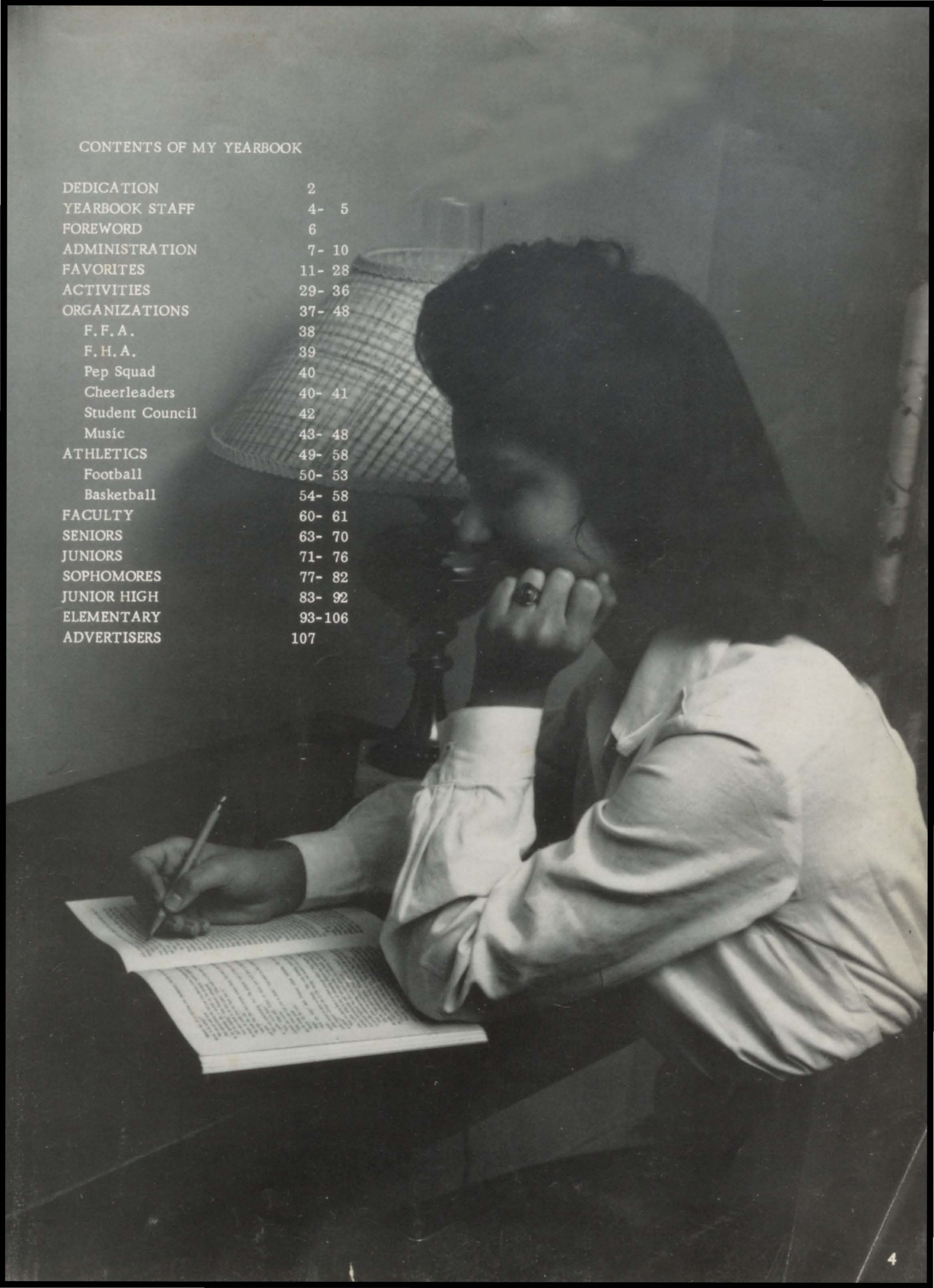

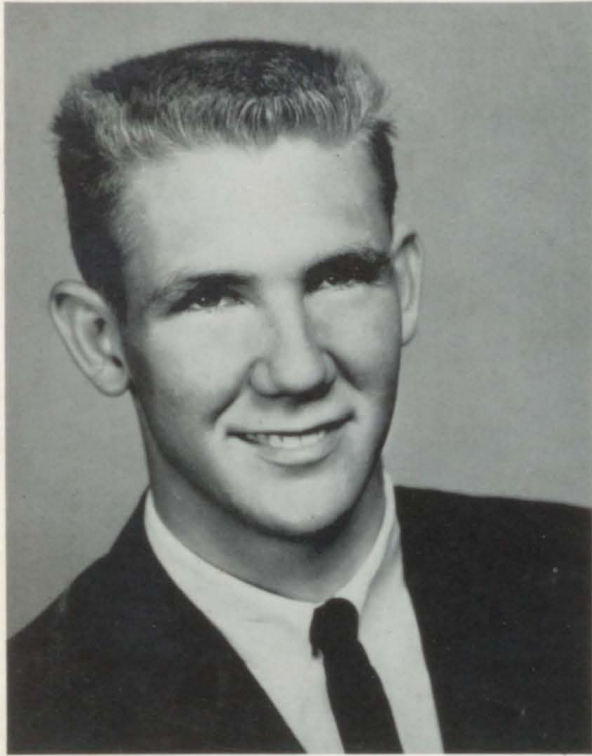
She was one of the finest teachers to teach at L-K High. Her constant study enabled her to put forth to her students the most modern ideas and discoveries in science.

The unanimous Declaration of the thirteen united States

We the People
Article 1

When in the course of human events it becomes necessary for one people to separate from another, and to assume among the powers of the earth, the separate and equal station to which the Laws of Nature and of Nature's God entitle them, a solemn and conscientious appeal is made to the Supreme Judge of the world for the rectitude of their intentions. In the first place, no people can be supposed to have relinquished their liberty and to have submitted to absolute monarchic sway, but by one of those extraordinary and singular occasions, which a just God rises up to punish the iniquity of their rulers, or to provide an opportunity for their liberation. And in the second place, no people can be supposed to have submitted to a government which has endeavored to bring upon them the most cruel and oppressive manner of taxation, and to have borne it, but by a succession of long and painful experience, which has convinced them that a change of their situation is not only their right, but their duty, and that the only security which they can have for the preservation of their liberties and safety, is by placing themselves under the protection of their own institutions, which they have the honor to propose to the united States of America.
