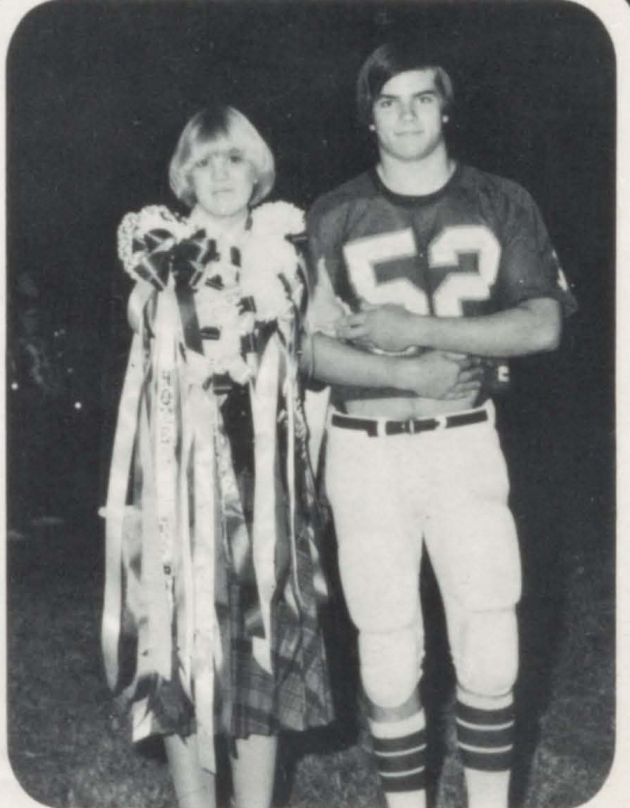

Texas Boys' States

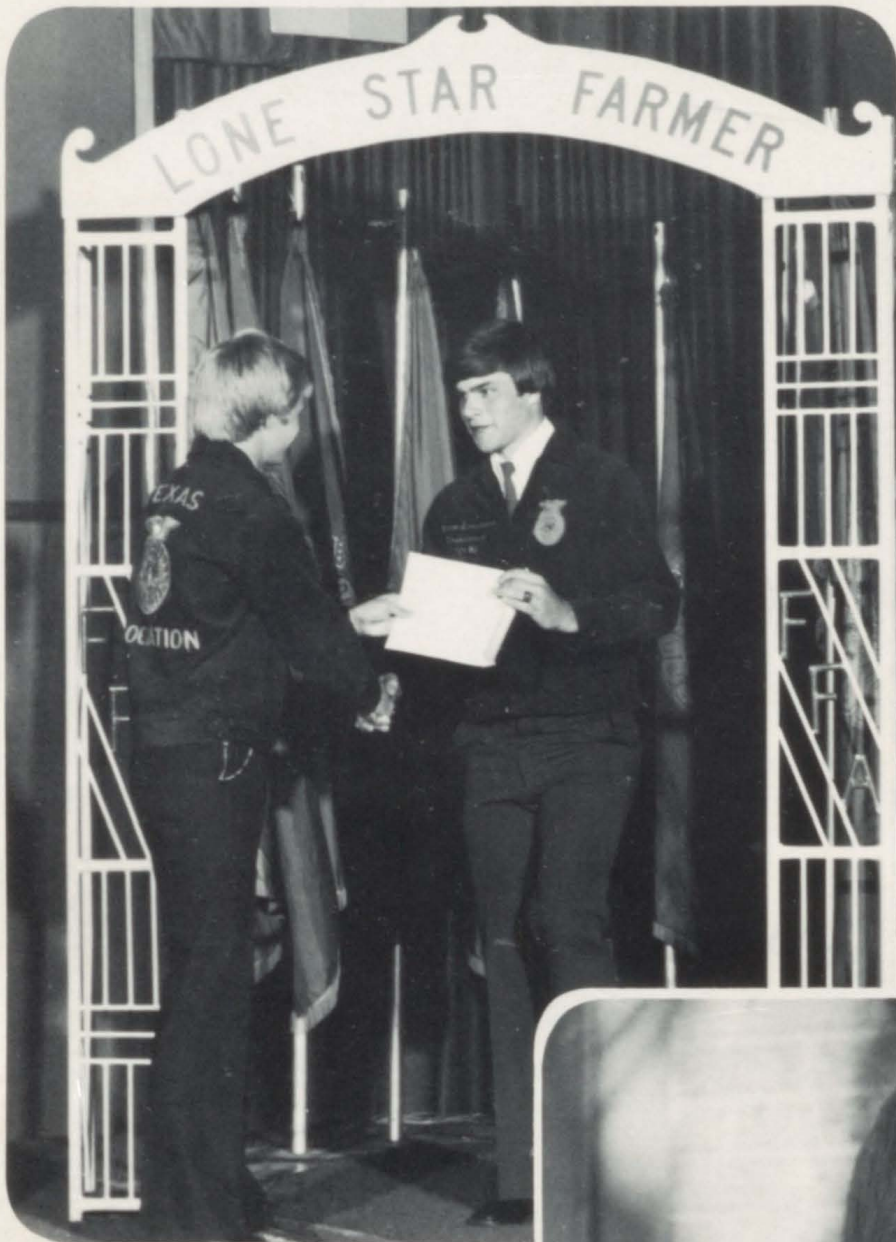
Linden-Kildare Was Represented by

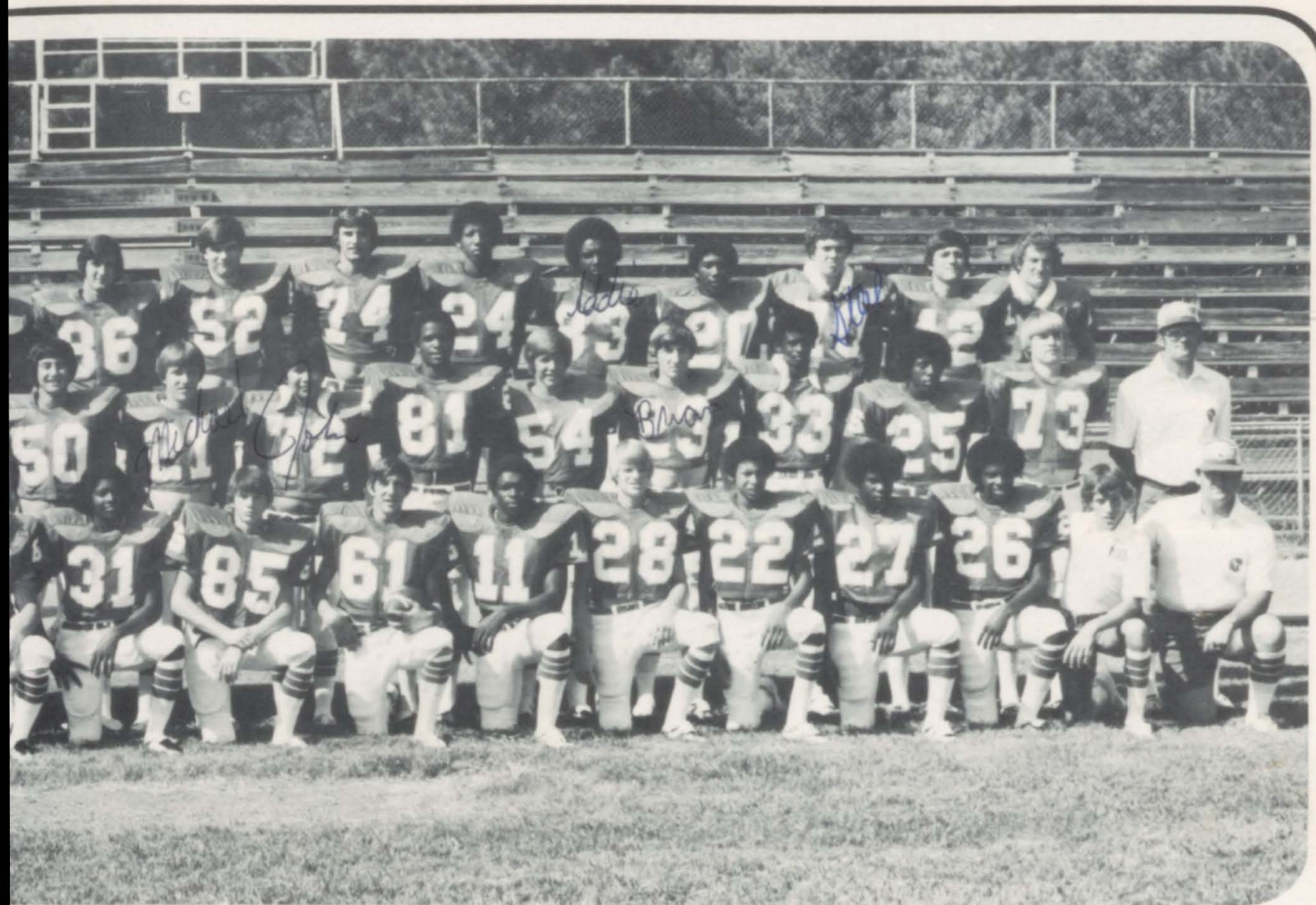
