
FOREWORD

JACK BROOKE

Staff Sergt. Julian J. (Jack)
Brooke served with Company "E"
38 Infantry. Sgt. Brooke entered
the service in 1940; served
overseas 8 months and was killed
in action during the Battle of
the Bulge in Belgium on December
18, 1944.

He was a star on the Linden High School football team during his high school career here.


His wife resides at Houston.

His parents Mr. and Mrs. C. R. Brooke live in Linden.

JONES COX

Pvt. Earl J. Cox, grandson of Mr. & Mrs. W. M. Cox, enlisted in the Army July 10, 1944. He served with the 1st Army, 26th Infantry and was killed in action on March 1, 1945 in the vicinity of Arp, Germany. He is buried in Belgium.

Jones resided in the Red Hill community and attended Linden High School. He would have graduated with the Senior Class of this year.







John Harold Ham was born Dec. 12, 1917. He joined the Navy April 1, 1937 and was reported missing March 2, 1941. He was reported officially dead Dec. 15, 1945.

John Harold attended Linden High School in 1934-35.

He was the son of Mr. & Mrs. Edgar Ham of the New Colony community.

W. L. KING

Pvt. W. L. King, Jr. entered the service November 29, 1943. As an infantryman he served until he was killed on April 16, 1945.

W. L. was a Sophomore in Linden High School. His parents Mr. & Mrs. W. L. King reside in the Caves Springs community.







JAMES HAROLD PENNY

Mr. & Mrs. Olen Penny of Mill Creek Community received a message on March 13, 1946, that their son, Harold had died on March 3, on Mindanao. No detail was given in the telegram.

Harold entered the Army in December, 1944, and had been overseas for 8 months prior to his reported death. He was first sent to Germany and then to Japan, where he died.

Harold attended Linden High School in 1941-1942.

ERROL O NEIL HOLLAND

S/Sgt. O'Neil Holland was the son of Mr. & Mrs. L. P. Holland who formerly lived in the Center Hill community but now live in Jena, Louisiana.

O'Neil entered the Army in April, 1943. He was killed on Okinawa April 8, 1945, only 4 days after landing there. He has a brother, Lavelle, in the Air Corp now.

O'Neil attended L.H.S. in 1941.





ERNEST PAUL KIRKLAND

Second Lt. Ernest Paul Kirkland of Linden enlisted in the Army Air Corp April 24, 1943. He was reported missing in action March 9, 1945. His parents, Mr. & Mrs. Jay Kirkland of the Almira community have recently received official notice of his death. He was their only child.

Ernest Paul graduated form Linden High School in May, 1942.

PAUL HORN LOVELACE

First Lt. Paul Horn lovelace of linden enlisted in the Army on June 19, 1942. Serving with Co. A, 350th Inf. 88th Division, he was killed in action October 12, 1944 in Northern Italy.

Paul Horn graduated from Linden High School in May, 1930. His parents, Mr.&Mrs. J. L. Lovelace and his wife, Mrs. Dee Lovelace, and daughter, Martha Dee, reside in Linden.







"BUD" McBURNETT

Pfc. V. W. (Bud) McBurnett Jr. enlisted in the army November 21, 1940. He was with the 36th Division, Co. L, 144th Inf.

"Bud", as he was known to us, was the son of Mr. & Mrs. V. W. McBurnett Sr. of the Red Hill community. He attended linden High School from 1938 to 1940.

He was killed June 29, 1945, at Mindanao in the Pacific.


CHARLES EUGENE STONE

First Lt. Charles Eugene Stone enlisted in the service on February 26, 1942, and served with the 109th Tactical Reconnaisance Squadron. His plane, "We Three" was reported missing in action on June 6, 1944, over Normandy, France. He was listed as dead December 5, 1944.

Thompson in the Red Hill community. His parents, Mr. & Mrs.
Lewis Stone live near Linden







JOE TATE

S/Sgt. Joe D. Tate served with the 32nd Bomb Sqd.,301st Bomb G. P. He enlisted in the Air Corp on August 30, 1940. His plane went down over Austria, Germany, February 25, 1944, whe he was on his forty-sixth mission. He was later pronounced killed in action October 11, 1945.

Joe graduated from Linden High School in May, 1940. He is survived by his parents, Mr. & Mrs. Joe Tate Sr.

WELDON YOUNG

Weldon Young, son of the late
Bub and Eunice Young, was left
an orphan in infancy. He was
reared by his grandmother, Mrs.
Sallie Boon and his uncle, Mr.
A. C. Boon in the Carterville
community. He graduated from
Linden High School in June, 1943

Weldon enlisted in the Army Air Corp in September, 1943, and served there until his death on November 30, 1944, when his plane crashed at Tuscon, Arizona He is buried in the Union Hill cemetery here in Cass County.
