Tigers get ready for Lions

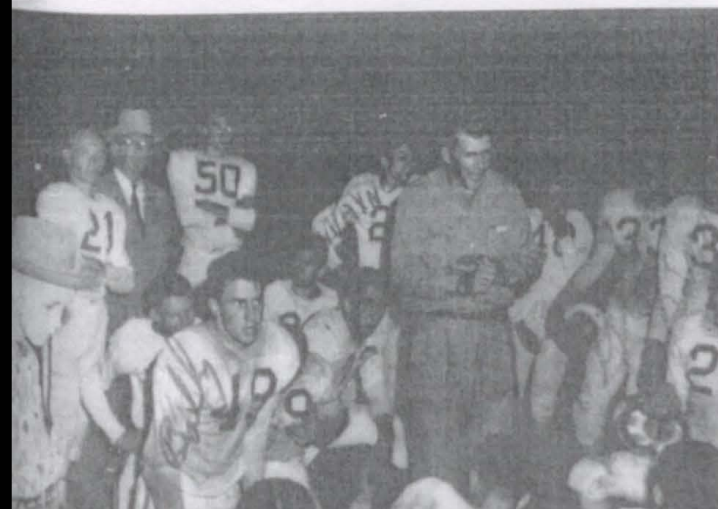

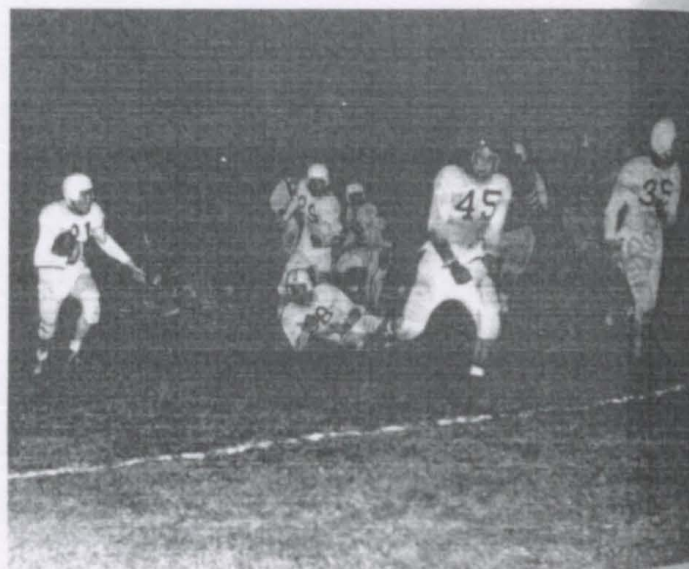




Hargett rambles through Tiger line
