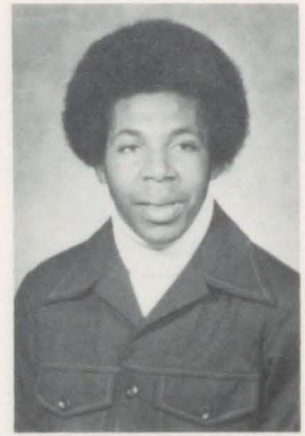
Yeah, I'm a senior so what about it?

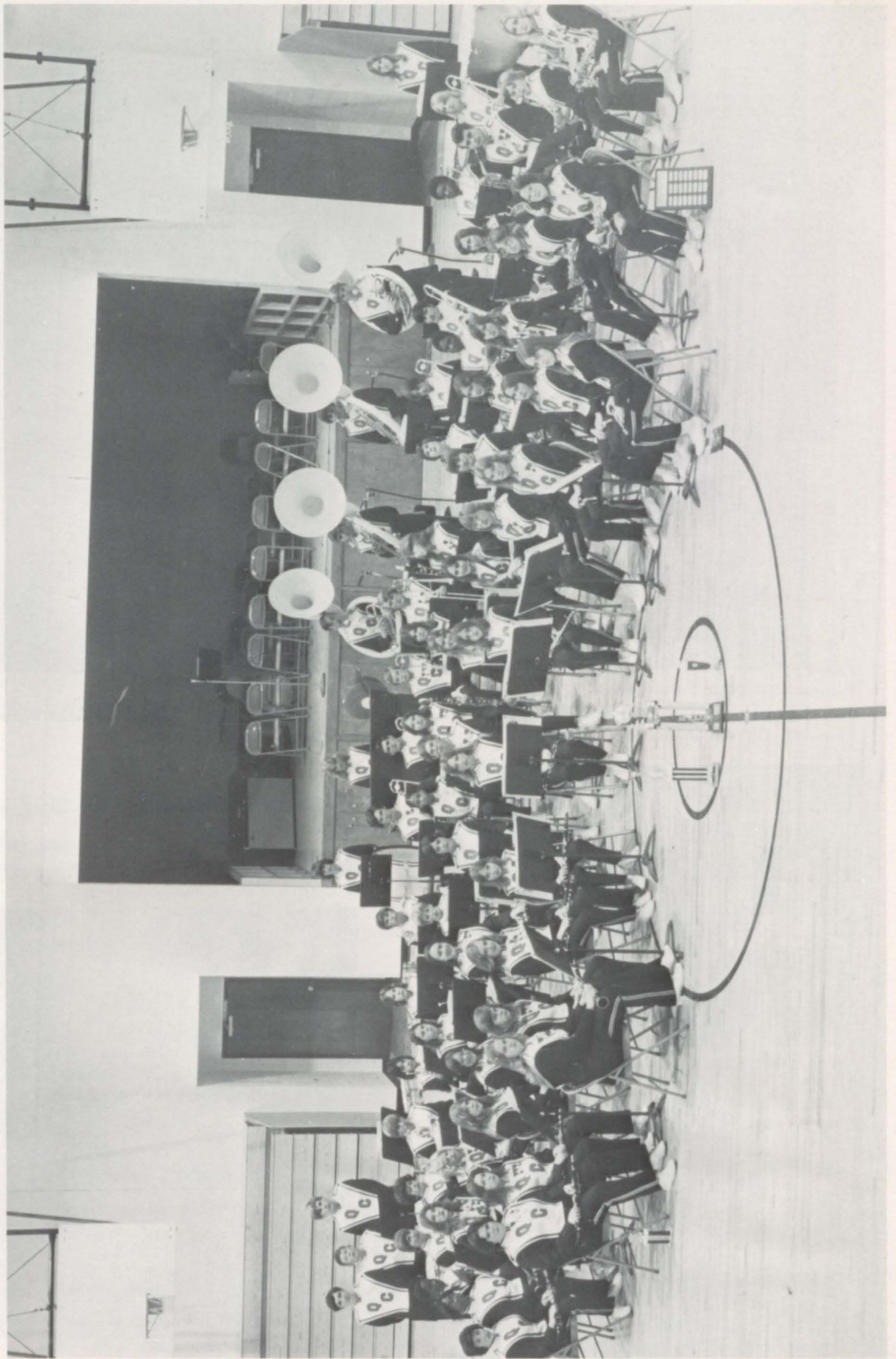

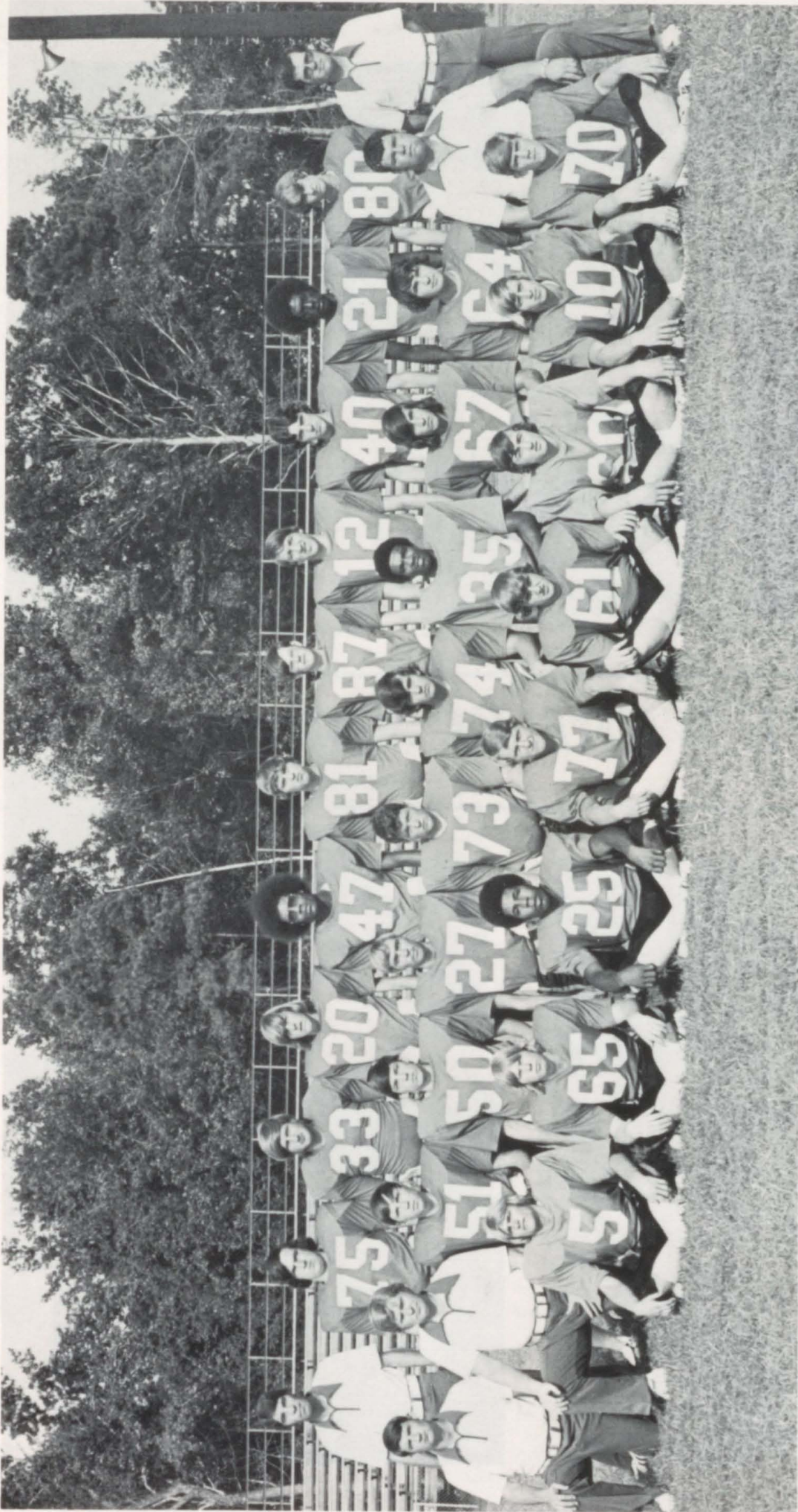

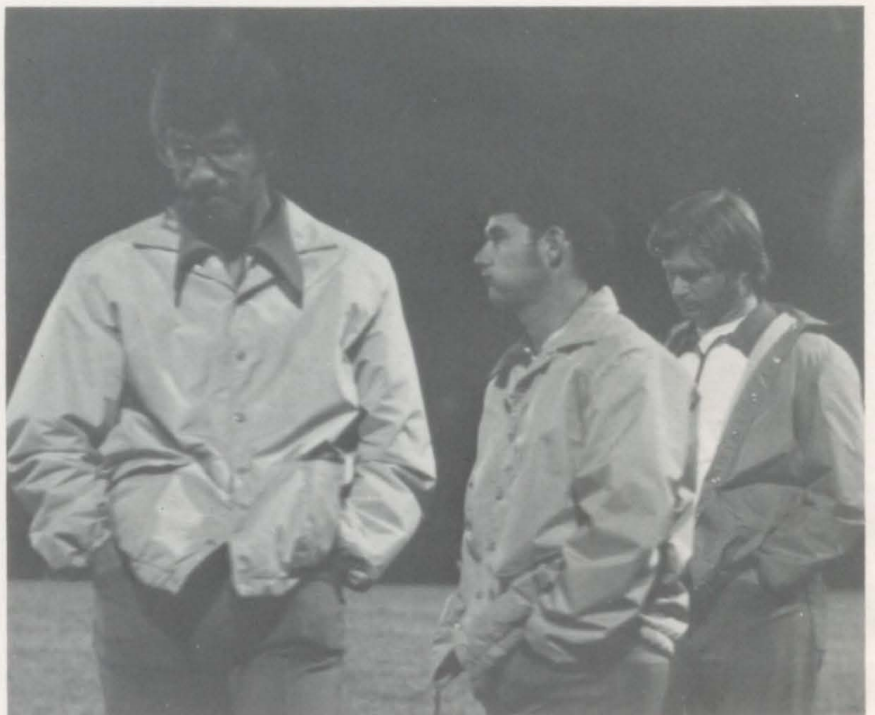

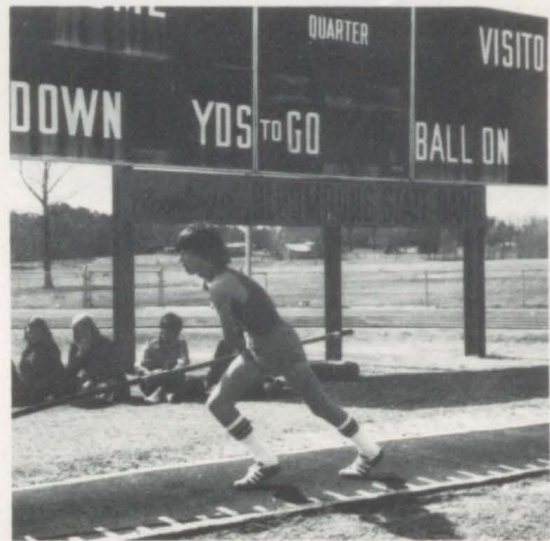

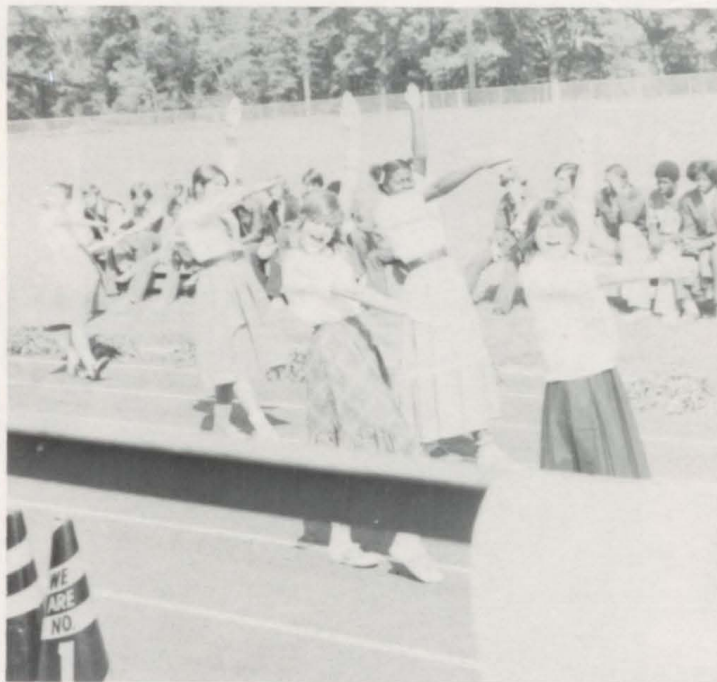

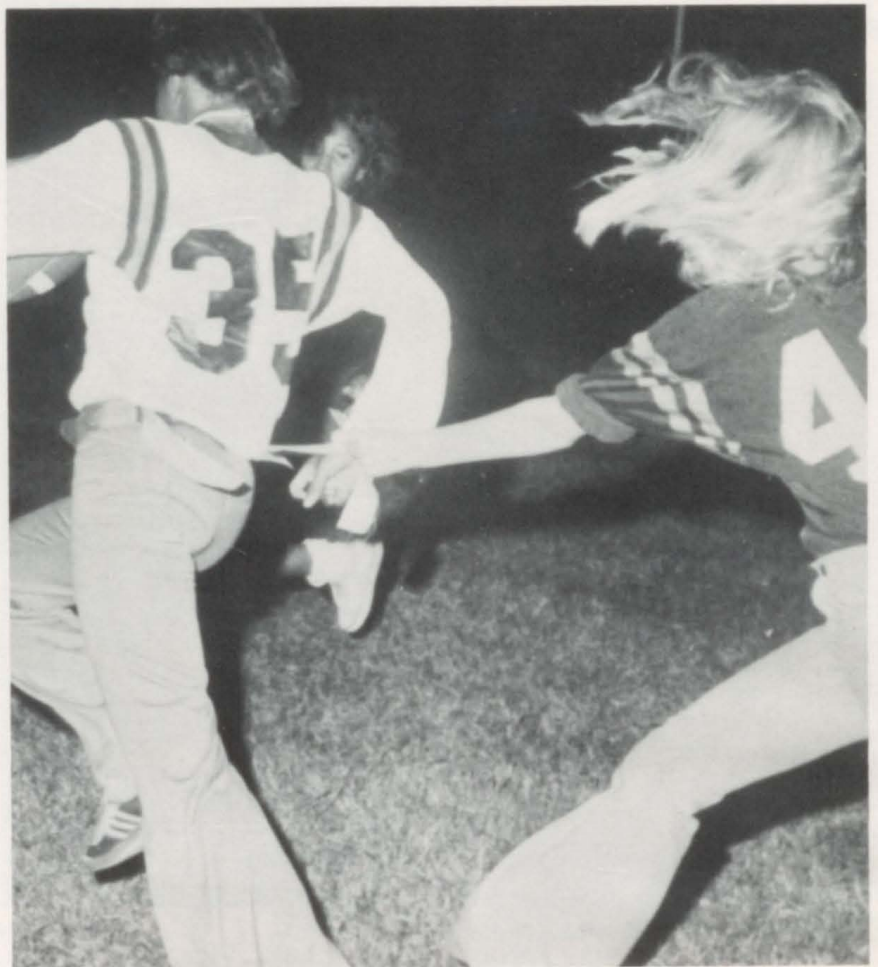
