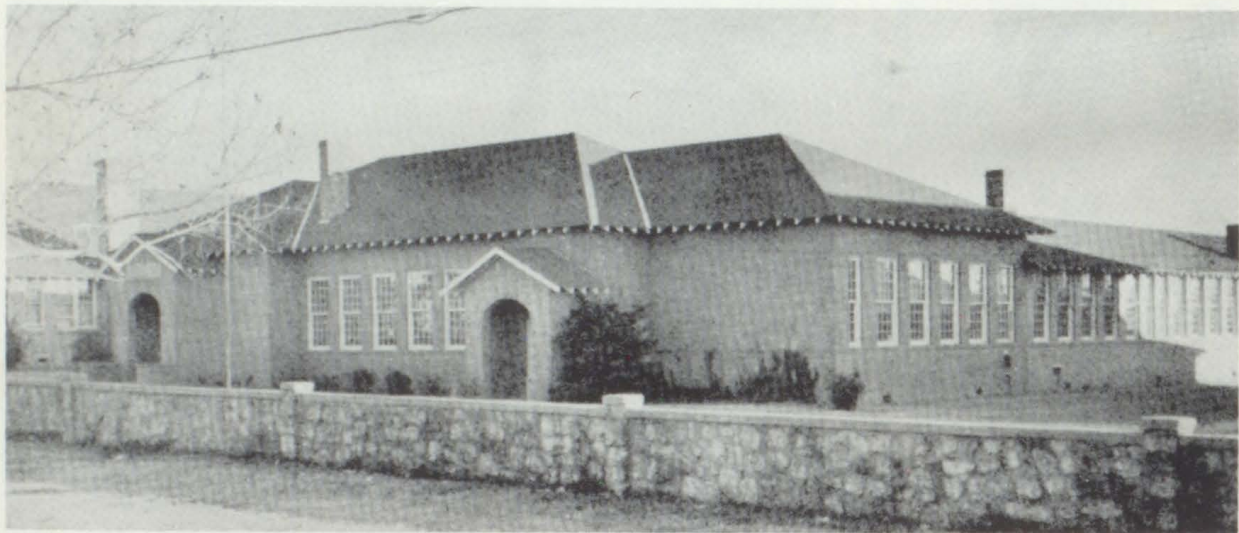
# Vivant le

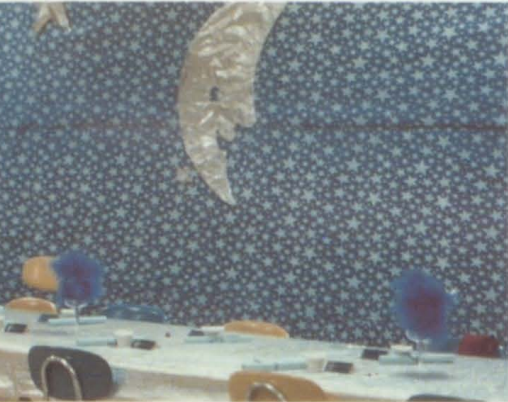

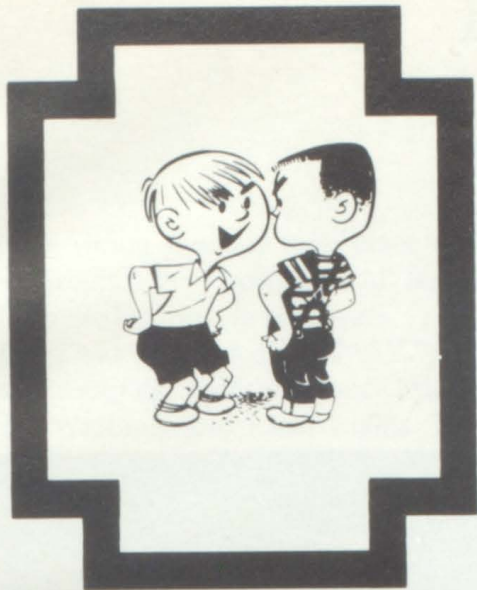

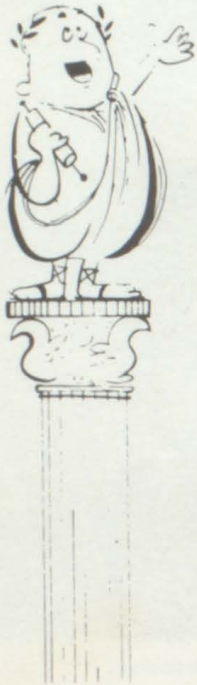
# Student Council Elections

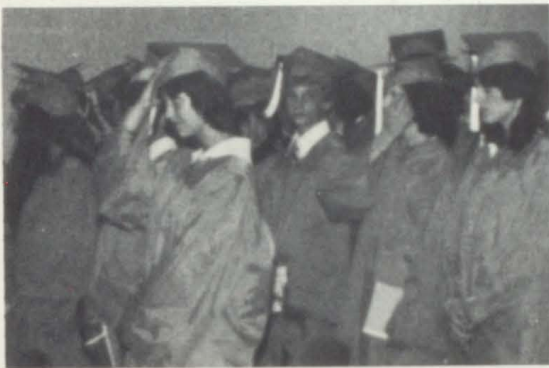
This banquet was the first one to be held in the new High School Cafetorium. The Theme for this Banquet was "The Stars are Out Tonight."



# Junior High Graduation



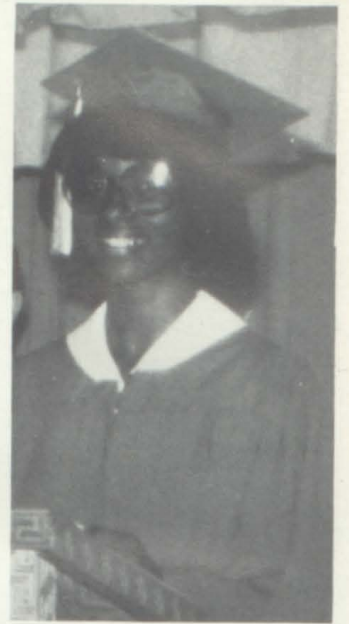

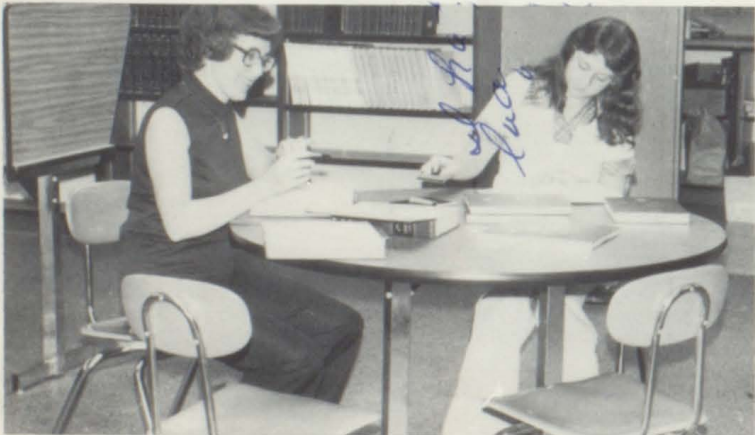

After the game, the Council sponsored a dance in the Cafetorium.



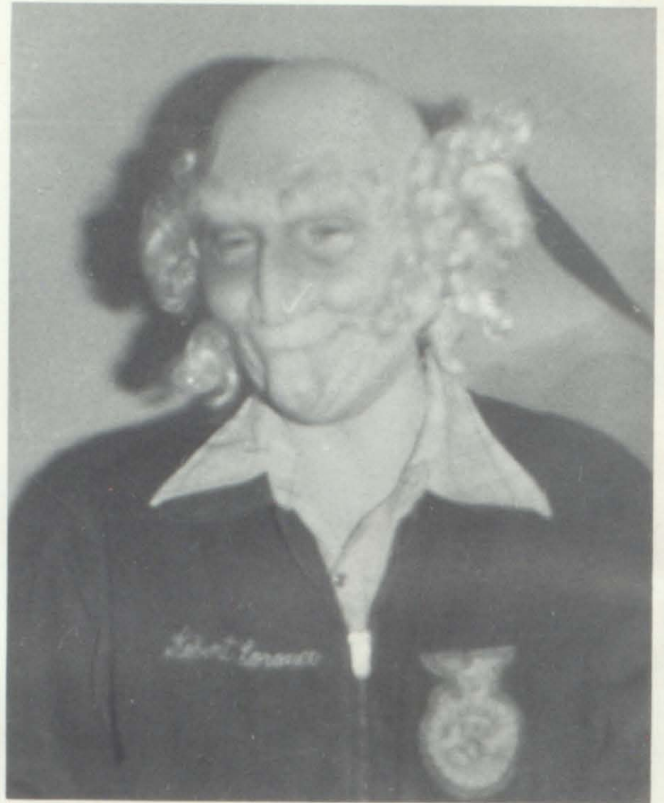

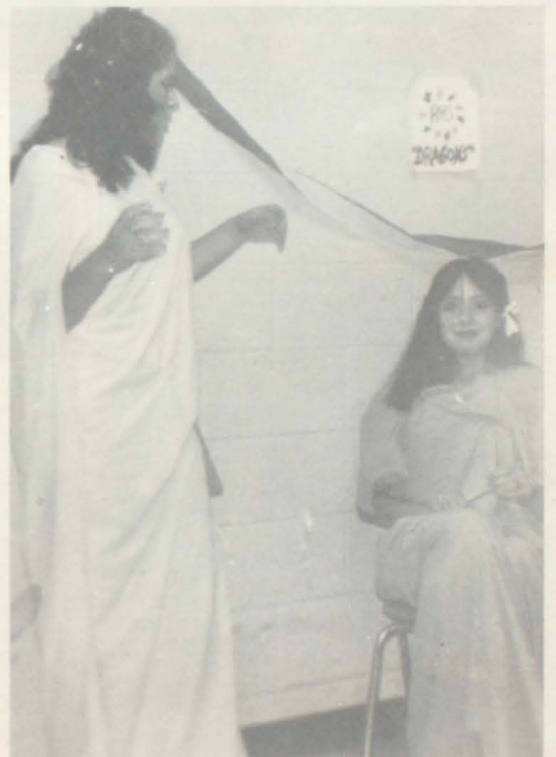
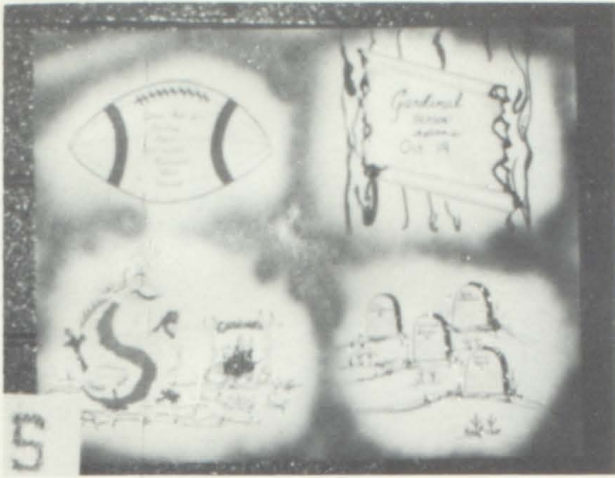
After a week of surprises, the faculty was given a special dinner by the Council. A good time was had by all, and the faculty enjoyed seeing their pals unveiled.

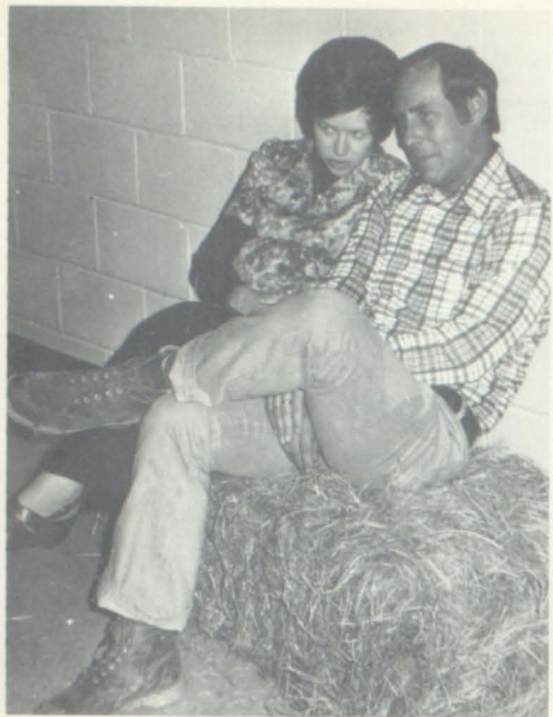
