19 — Senior Trip — 81



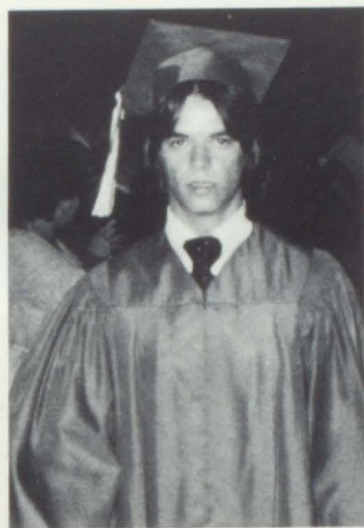
